Before Loading/Unloading

Are vehicle driver and UT employee present? Is spill kit nearby and properly stocked with materials?

Is secondary containment in place (if applicable)? Are fuel delivery and oil spill signs in place and legible? Does tank have sufficient capacity to accept fuel? Are wheels of delivery vehicle chocked? Is the vehicle leak free? Is the vehicle parking brake on? Is vehicle motor shut down? Minimum distance of 25 feet between vehicle and AST? Is the nearest drain, or drains, protected? Are tank and hose connections tight and secure?

During Loading/Unloading

Is level gauge working? Does tank have sufficient capacity? Are connections leaking? If yes, is spill containment in place? (tray, pan) Any evidence of fuel/oil on the ground?

After Loading/Unloading
