

# IN CASE OF WORK INJURY

- In case of work injury, notify your supervisor.
- For medical emergencies, call 911 and ask to be transported to the nearest hospital.
- During normal business hours, minor medical treatment, including minor chemical & lab animal exposures, are treated on-campus by the UT *HealthPoint* Occupational Health Program. Call 512.471.4OHP(4647) for an appointment.
- After hours, choose an urgent care provider of your choice that is in the workers' compensation IMO Network using the Find-a-Provider search tool.

- If your incident is after hours and involves exposure to lab animals, chemicals or biological agents, go to St. David's Medical Center emergency room\* to initiate post-exposure treatment.

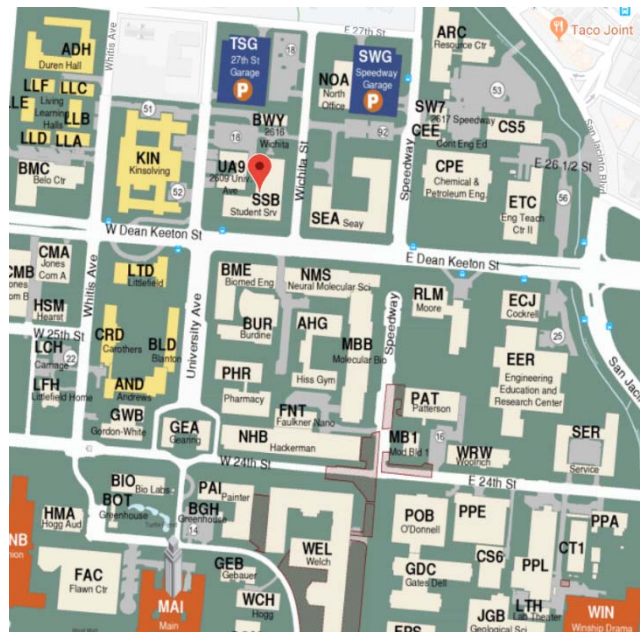
