- Individuals who live with, or have had sexual contact with, someone who has Hepatitis A.

Symptoms Associated With Hepatitis A

Fever

Loss of Appetite

Yellow Eyes or Skin (Jaundice)

Nausea and Vomiting

Abdominal Pain and Discomfort

Dark Urine or Pale Stool
