



Triple Packaging

- Packaging used must be constructed to prevent any leakage and in good condition
- Packaging consist of three components:
 - Leak-proof primary receptacles (i.e. vials)
 - Secure caps/lids with parafilm or tape
 - Leak-proof secondary packaging (i.e. ziplock bag)
 - Place absorbent pads/materials for liquids in sufficient quantity to absorb the entire contents.
 - Place between primary and secondary packaging.
 - Multiple fragile (glass) primary receptacles placed in a single secondary packaging must be either individually wrapped or separated to prevent contact (i.e.: bubble wrap)
- Outer packaging of adequate strength for its capacity, mass and intended use.
 - Two boxes are not required, but it will provide additional protection from breakage.
